Before you visit a Center, please call the Center you are planning to visit to find out what their hours are and days they are open. The list that is listed here may no longer be accurate. The Blood Bank is changing and I have not been able to find out how they are changing.

The only thing that will not change is the Blood Bank's need for donors. The Blood Bank services 80 Southern California hospitals which means they must collect 500 donations daily to be able to support the 80 facilities. That means they need for each Center to collect 62 donations per day. Given the task of getting new donors, this is a real problem for the Blood Bank and it is why I hound you all to get out and donate. Donating is a community service and it will make you feel good about yourself.

Donating is not just for adults. If you have a 15 year old at home, get them started donating. Make it a family affair to donate together. The personnel at each Center are really nice people and come from a variety of backgrounds. They are good conversationalists and care about you as a donor and as a person. Your 15y/o will need your permission to donate but it will be a good experience for them to understand how what they are doing is saving another person's life. They can also find out about the process itself.

I am a donor myself and have been for a long time. I enjoy the staff and have met so many neat people at the Blood Bank. These are friends that have lasted a long time. So there are many benefits to donating. Come and donate and enjoy the people experience.


